Heritage listed Transport House, 7 to 9 storey sandstone building with classical design and art deco elements was built in 1938 for the Department of Roads, Transport and Tramway.

M&C Saatchi occupy levels 1 to 4 at Transport House with a total floor area of 3,400sqm. The premises has dual entries, Macquarie and Phillips Streets, and it occupies the most significance space within the heritage list building, a two-storey space called Registration Hall.
